## 28 **Abbaye de la Bussière** Bussière, France

When the British Cummings family arrived at this former Cistercian abbey in 2005, they took vows of luxury and elegance – now amply fulfilled. Slotted into the hidden Ouche (pron: “Oosh”) valley and surrounded by 35-acre grounds, the magnificent old pile is sumptuous with comfort, stately style and temptations enough to distract the most ascetic of abbots.
